

# BCCI holds Bahraini-Indian week tomorrow

**E**nhanced economic relations between Bahrain and India will be the focus of a high-powered forum that will take place tomorrow at 9:00am in the Palm Hall of Bahrain International Exhibition and Convention Centre. The event will be held under the patronage of the Minister of

Industry, Commerce and Tourism, Zayed bin Rashid Alzayani.
